As part of our process to maintain capacity on standard product lines sold to multiple customers, Littelfuse is taking the following actions for the xEV fuse series:

Littelfuse is adding a second melamine supplier. This second source has been used for several years on other Littelfuse fuses. It's worth mentioning that both melamine's have the same characteristics. No other change is going to be made to the products. This additional source will not have any impact on the fit, form & function of the product.

Littelfuse is working on the corresponding validation plan. Test results will be available and shared accordingly upon request.
